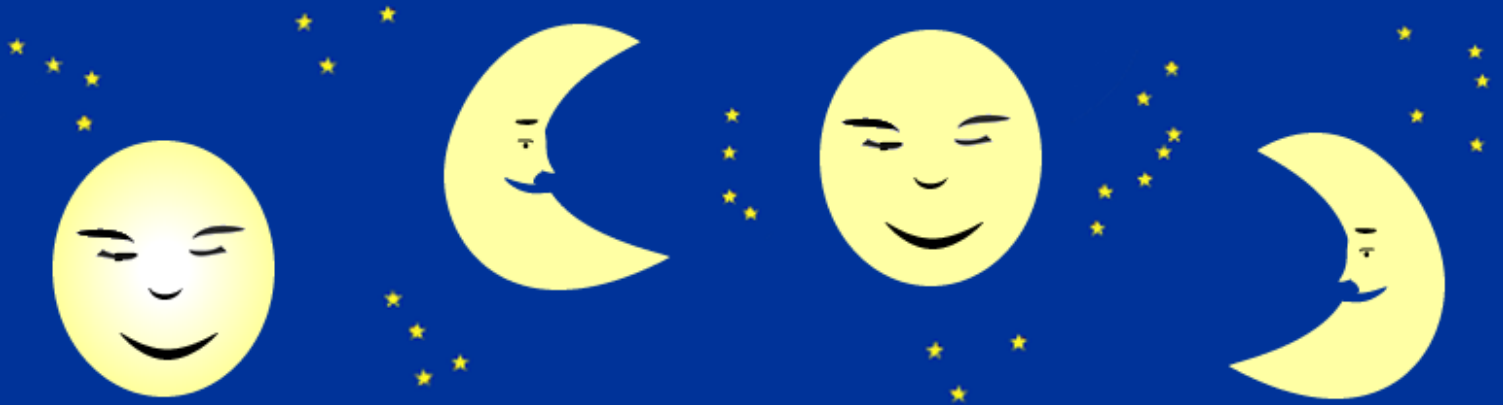

Planting by the Moon – July 2011

Time for the home and family, caring for and repairing the home and garden. Make the most the cooler weather (it won't last long!) with family barbeques and walks, along with those restoration jobs.

| 1 July | New Moon. |
| 2-3 July | This is the best tie to sow leafy annuals – rosemary, basil, silverbeet. |
| 7 July | Next best time for leafy annuals. Plant new bare-rooted roses now. |
| 10-11 July | Best time for fruiting annuals. Try some climbers – okra (<i>Hibiscus esculentus</i>), cucumber, Panama Gold passionfruit. |
| 18-20 July | Best time for propagating root crops – still time for another row of carrots inter- sown with radish. |
| 21-23 July | Best time to harvest rosella (<i>Hibiscus sabdariffa</i>), turmeric and ginger. |
| 24-30 July | Garden maintenance time. Keep up with the weeding! |
| 31 July | New Moon. |
