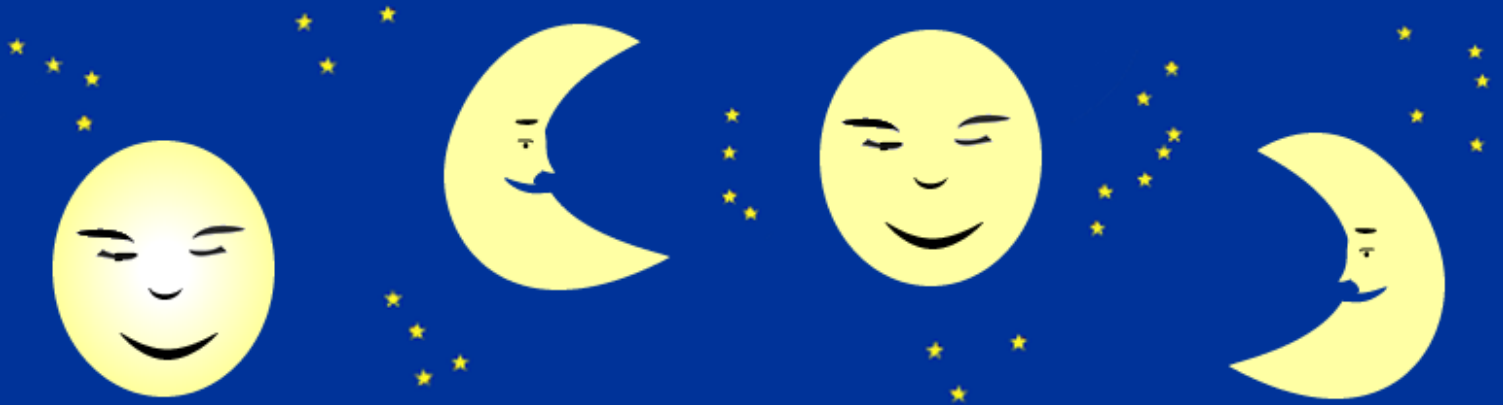

| 2 June | New Moon. |
| 3-5 June | This is the best time to sow the seeds of leafy annuals – all the brassica family are suitable for planting now. A large variety of mints are available and do well these cooler months. |
| 10-11 June | Next best time for fruiting annuals. |
| 12-14 June | Best time for fruiting annuals – mung beans, climbing beans, heritage tomatoes – in A vast range of colours, shapes and sizes. |
| 16 June | Full Moon eclipse. |
| 17-18 June | Next best time for root crops. |
| 21-22 June | Best time for root crops – sweet potato, cassava. Also time to harvest edible ginger. |
| 22 June | Winter solace – shortest day. |
| 25-30 June | Garden maintenance time. Check irrigation systems, repair and replace as necessary. Apply organic fertilizer to vegetable crops. |
